We accept professional responsibility for our individual decisions and actions. We are also advocates for Umpqua Valley Winegrowers by engaging in activities that enhance its credibility and value.

Intent

- To assist Umpqua Valley Winegrowers in achieving its objectives and goals.
- To encourage professional decision-making and dialogue.
